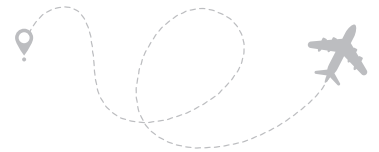


















STADSHUSET Stockholm City Hall



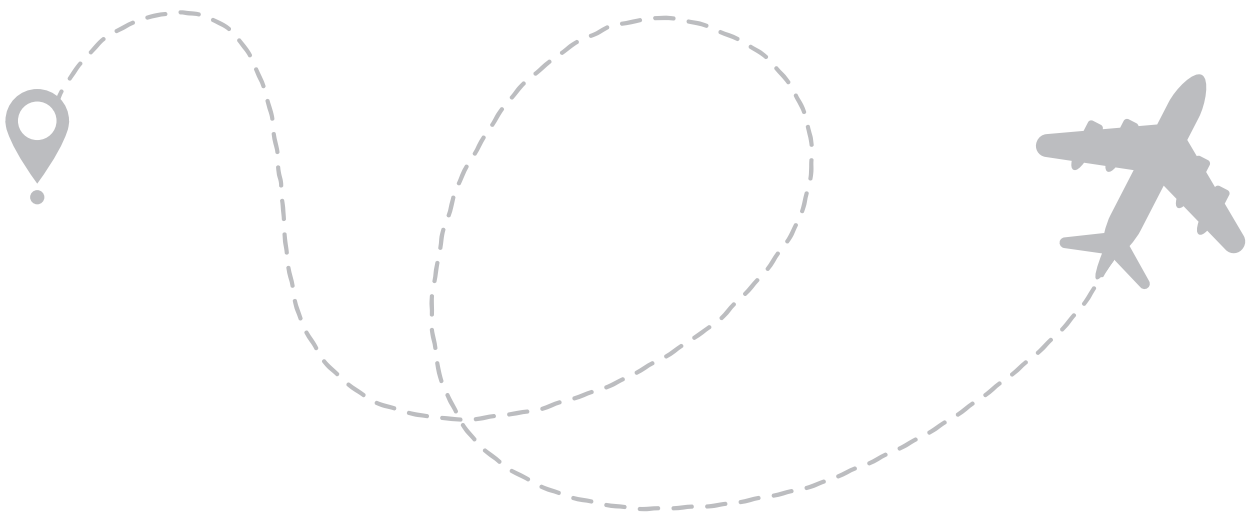
Designed by one of Sweden's best architects of the time, Ragnar Östberg, The Stockholm City Hall or Stadshuset was inaugurated on June 23th 1923 exactly 400 years after King Gustav Vasa arrived to Stockholm. The City Hall is where all the offices of the City Council and the different committees are located, and it is the most visited building in Stockholm. Located on the island of Kungsholmen and facing Lake Mälaren and the island of Södermalm, The City Hall offers a fantastic view of the city.

But without a doubt the most important and world famous event that is held here, is The Nobel Prize Banquet in honor of all the Nobel Prize Laureates celebrated every December 10th, on the anniversary of Alfred Nobel's death.

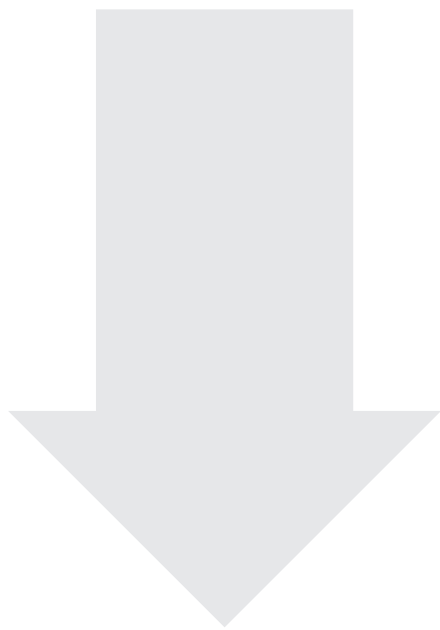

ICEBAR by ICEHOTEL



The ICEBAR by ICEHOTEL in Stockholm is the first permanent Icebar in the World, inaugurated in 2002. But this is not only a bar, it's a slice of northern Sweden's polar magic, a magnificent experience.

ICEBAR Stockholm is totally made of blocks of ice that comes from the pristine waters from the Torne River in the northern part of Sweden.

Every year the decoration changes thanks to the artistic design and vision created by different ice designers. The tables, chairs and even the glasses from which you drink are made of ice. The bar has a constant temperature of -5°C (23°F).

If you just want to do something different and relax for a moment, the ICEBAR Stockholm is the perfect place, where even children are welcomed with a colorful non-alcoholic drink.

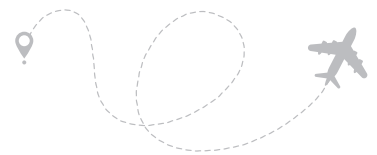

GAMLA STAN



Without a doubt, one of the most visited places in Stockholm is Gamla Stan or the Old Town located on the island of Stadsholmen.

The Old Town is considered one of the best preserved Medieval areas in Europe.

Gamla Stan is full of history and traditions. It is surrounded by museums and residences that belonged to the Nobility. Historic and iconic buildings such as the Stockholm Cathedral or Storkyrkan dating back to the 1270s; the Tessinska Palace, Skeppsbron and of course the magnificent Royal Palace, the official residence of His Majesties the King and Queen of Sweden, are located here.

Its cobbled stone streets and colorful buildings dating back to the Middle Ages, along with its narrow alleys and squares, are steeped in history.
