

GAMLA STAN



Without a doubt, one of the most visited places in Stockholm is Gamla Stan or the Old Town located on the island of Stadsholmen.

The Old Town is considered one of the best preserved Medieval areas in Europe.

Gamla Stan is full of history and traditions. It is surrounded by museums and residences that belonged to the Nobility. Historic and iconic buildings such as the Stockholm Cathedral or Storkyrkan dating back to the 1270s; the Tessinska Palace, Skeppsbron and of course the magnificent Royal Palace, the official residence of His Majesties the King and Queen of Sweden, are located here.

Its cobbled stone streets and colorful buildings dating back to the Middle Ages, along with its narrow alleys and squares, are steeped in history. Gamla Stan is a vibrant tourist and residential area, full of vibrant shops, art galleries, restaurants, bars and cafes, making it the perfect place to start enjoying "Stockholm, The Capital of Scandinavia".



STORKYRKAN STOCKHOLM CATHEDRAL

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The Stockholm Cathedral or Storkyrkan, is considered to be the oldest building in Stockholm, as it is already mentioned in historical documents dating back to 1279.

The Cathedral is also known as the Church of Saint Nicholas, as it is dedicated to Saint Nicholas the patron of sea merchants and sailors.


It is located in Gamla Stan, the Old Town on the island of Stadsholmen, where Stockholm was founded in 1252.

In the Cathedral you can see two of the most important works of art in Sweden.

One of them is the sculpture of Sankt Göran och Draken or Saint George and the Dragon, made by Bernt Nokte in 1489.

The second is the famous painting Vädersolstavlan or Sun Dog, which is an optical phenomenon that happened in Stockholm on April 20, 1535, due to the refraction of light into a large number of ice particles in the clouds. This oil painting is considered to be the first "photograph" of Stockholm.

This Cathedral, which has been Lutheran Protestant since 1527, has been the official Royal Church for all royal weddings, including the wedding of Crown Princess Victoria, heir to the throne of Sweden, to Daniel Westling on June 19, 2010.





MÄRTEN TROTZIGS ALLEY



It is named after the German merchant Mårten Trotzig (1559-1617), who lived here and who established his spice shop at the end of the steps of this alley.

This hidden place is the smallest, narrowest and steepest alley in Gamla Stan. It has 36 steps and in its narrowest point, it is only 35 inches or 90 centimeters wide.

This alley connects two of the most visited streets in Gamla Stan, Prästgatan and Västerlånggatan.





THE ROYAL PALACE




Located in Gamla Stan or The Old Town, The Royal Palace of Stockholm has more than 1,400 rooms, 11 floors and only 1 balcony, and is the official residence of their majesties the King and Queen of Sweden. The Palace is also the largest official Royal residence in Europe, even larger than Buckingham Palace in London.

In 1697, the Medieval Castle of the Tre Kronor was practically destroyed after a fire. The King at that time, Karl XII commissioned the royal architect, Nicodemus Tessin d.. to design the new Palace.


Built in the Italian Baroque style and with its interiors mainly in the Rococo style, the Royal Palace is considered to be one of the most emblematic buildings of the Baroque era in Europe.

The offices of the Royal Court, as well as the Treasury Museum, the Armory Museum, the Tre Kronor Museum and the Gustav III Museum of Antiquities, are located here.

In 2011, a complete renovation of the Palace façade began, so that it will look exactly as it was during the 1600s. It is estimated that it will take almost 25 years to completed and it is considered to be the largest stonework renovation project in the world.

RIDDARHOLMEN



Riddarholmen or the Island of the Royal Knights, is one of the 4 islands that make up Gamla Stan or the Old City since its foundation in 1252.

In the 1200s, the Monastery of the Franciscan Order or Gråbrödraklostret was located here. Today on this site stands the spectacular Riddarholmskyrka Church or Riddarholm Church, which has been the coronation church and royal mausoleum from the mid-1250s to 1950. A total of 17 monarchs are buried here, with the exception of Queen Kristina. Riddarholmskyrkan is the only monastery church that has been preserved since the Middle Ages in Stockholm. Now the church is only used for special ceremonies and no longer offers regular services.

This island is full of magnificent palaces that belonged to Swedish nobility during the 1600s, such as Wrangel Palace, which was the temporary home of the Royal Family for almost 60 years when Tre Kronor Castle burned down in 1697.

From here you will have a fantastic view of the Stockholm City Hall, Lake Mälaren and Riddarfjärden, Knight's Bay.

Since 2010 not a single person lives on this island.



SKEPPSHOLMEN

Historically, the island of Skeppsholmen is undoubtedly one of the most important islands among the 14 islands that make up Stockholm, not to mention that it is one of the most beautiful and best preserved.

This island has been a shipyard and a naval and military island since the early Middle Ages, as it is strategically located at the entrance to Stockholm by the Baltic Sea and practically in front of the Royal Palace.

Skeppsholmen and its buildings dating back to the 1600s, have been declared cultural heritage by the Stockholm City Museum. Many of these buildings have been converted into museums, concert halls, restaurants, hotels and bars, among others. Even Benny Andersson, the former member of ABBA has his world famous recording studio here.

On the islet of Kastellholmen, connected to Skeppsholmen by one of Stockholm's 60 bridges, you can visit the Kastellet Fortress.

This fortification, dedicated to the protection of the city since the Middle Ages until World War II, the flag with the naval military ensign has been hoisted every day for more than 200 years, to indicate that Sweden is in peace and that it is not occupied by any foreign enemies.
